## *Generation No. 1*

### **1. Benjamin (Moreland)<sup>1</sup> Morlan<sup>l</sup>** was born Abt. 1630 in England<sup>l</sup>.

Notes for Benjamin (Moreland) Morlan:

Supposedly emigrated to America in 1670 at the age of 40.

Settled in New Jersey.

I have seen sources saying this Benjamin Moreland was from Kent, England. He may have arrived on a ship named Kent, and was not from "Kent".

May have arrived with this group on the ship Kent:

The Kent carried colonists to West New Jersey with Gregory Marlow as master and loaded in London for New Jersey 19 March to 31 March 1677. There followed loadings for other ports, but she sailed before May. The Kent sailed first to New York, arriving either the 4th, 12th or 16th August. Then after a short stay, the Kent sailed across the bay to Perth Amboy, after which she headed south to the Delaware, landing first at the mouth of Raccoon Creek where she is said to have disembarked some 230 passengers of a total of 270. She then moved on to Chygoes Island, now Burlington. Other histories state that she landed at Raccoon Creek after an early June halt at New Castle, then to Burlington on 23 June. However, the arrival time in New York is known from the minutes of the New York government, with which the Commissioners (aboard the Kent) met during their stay there. The Yorkshire purchasers settled the 1st tenth, from Assinpink to Rancocas. The London purchasers settled the 2nd tenth, from Rancocas to Timber Creek.

According to genealogist George William Gillett, from 2007:

JOHN MORLAN, son of Benjamin Morlan, was born probably in England on November 30, 1657, but was

recorded in Newby Stead, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania. This was registered at the Strickland Monthly Meeting - the record system of the Society of Friends or more normally called Quakers.

Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, is located about twenty miles east of Pittsburgh or about 400 miles inland. This would probably mean that this was one of their record centers with John not actually being born there of course.

**8. William B. (Moreland)<sup>3</sup> Morlan** (John (Moreland)<sup>2</sup>, Benjamin (Moreland)<sup>1</sup>)<sup>5,6,7</sup> was born 1720 in Bordentown, Burlington Co., NJ.<sup>8</sup>, and died 1790 in South River, Bedford Co., VA.<sup>9,10</sup>. He married **Sarah French**<sup>11</sup> 03 Jan 1740/41<sup>12</sup>, daughter of Richard French and Mary King. She was born 20 Jan 1714/15 in Mansfield, Burlington Co., NJ., and died 01 Dec 1798 in Goose Creek, Bedford Co., VA.<sup>13,14</sup>.

Notes for William B. (Moreland) Morlan:  
From the genealogy of George William Gillett, 2007:

The William Morlans were living in Chesterfield, Burlington County, New Jersey, until about 1758. They then started to move south to Virginia as recorded by the records from the Redstone Monthly Meeting House. This was an era in which a number of Quakers started to move south from Pennsylvania and New Jersey into the mid-southern states, Virginia and the Carolinas. The movement was caused by the unrest in the north prior to the Revolutionary War.

The MORLANS had moved to Loudoun County, Virginia where William was listed as being granted 36 acres of land in 1774. Loudoun County is just west of Washington D.C.

D.A.R. (Daughters of the American Revolution) records indicate that William Morlan had joined in the Revolutionary War with Captain Samuel Woodson's Company, the 9th Virginian. These records are located in the Virginia State Library in Richmond, Virginia, as indicated in the application for membership to the National Society of the Daughters of the American Revolution. "I certify that on four pay rolls of Samuel Woodson's Company (for April 1777, for May 1777, for June 1777 and October 1777) appears the name of William Moorland (Morlan, Morland, Mourtand)". Signed H.R. McIlwain, State Librarian, July 22, 1913.                      See: MORLAN FAMILY in AMERICAN REVOLUTION

The Quaker records did not indicate that William Morlan was ever disowned from the Society for bearing arms, which was normally the case. Because of this it might be possible that this was not the same William Morlan, although the D.A.R. has approved the records.

The Morlans had moved to Bedford County, Virginia, about 1780. This part of Virginia, Bedford and Campbell counties, was very strong in the Quaker religion at that time. There were a number of Societies (churches) in the area.

Bedford County is located in the southwest part of the state between Roanoke and Lynchburg, Virginia. Lynchburg was a city built by the Quakers. In 1805 the population was about 500 people of which a large percentage were Quakers.

THESE ARTICLES MAY OR MAY NOT BE THIS JOHN:

1772 Feb. 7. "Supposed to be taken out of the Subscriber's drawer this morning by [a person who calls himself William Morland, but supposed not to be his real name] William Morlin, two joes and 11 half joes, one milled pistol, and about twenty pounds in paper money. Said Morlin is about 5 ft. 10 or 11 inches high, aged about 27 years, a well set fellow, pitted with the small pox, has lightish eyes and dark curled hair; had on when he went away a coarse hat, a blue surtout with cross pockets, a blue tight bodied coat, and blue double breasted vest, fine shirt marked H.R.; a striped silk handkerchief about his neck; and had four more of same piece; buckskin breeches rather too short for him, redish brown and white mixed worsted stockings, new pumps with yellow carved buckles in them. He calls himself this country born, but, from his dialect, is supposed to be a West-country man. Whoever takes up the said fellow, and secures him in any of his Majesty's goals, so that he may be convicted of the theft, shall have the above reward, and all reasonable charges, paid by William Shreeve". 1772 June 1. Philadelphia. "On Saturday the 16th ult. the Supreme Court for the province of NJ ended, .....At the same Court, William Morlan, alias William Newman alias William Blakely, alias John Morlan was convicted of Grand Larceny and burnt in the hand."NJ Archives Vol. XXVIII page 155.

(Moreland)<sup>3</sup>, John (Moreland)<sup>2</sup>, Benjamin (Moreland)<sup>1</sup>)<sup>16,17</sup> was born 06 Jun 1742 in probably New Jersey<sup>18</sup>, and died 10 Feb 1824 in Columbiana Co., OH.<sup>19</sup>. He married **Anna Nancy "Nancy" Richardson** 28 Dec 1765 in Fairfax, Loudoun Co., VA., Monthly Meeting, daughter of William Richardson and Ann Harris. She was born 29 Sep 1747 in Coles Mill, Anne Arundel Co., MD.<sup>20,21</sup>, and died 1830 in Columbiana Co., OH..

Jason Morelan [sic] and Ann Richardson, both members of our meeting married contrary to discipline. Disowned. They were reinstated in 1770. In 1777 Jason and Ann Morelan were condemned for holding slaves and for selling a slave into bondage, disowned 1777. Their children, Sarah, Rebecca, Ann, Jason and Joseph were removed some years ago with their parents and settled near Redstone PM, PA. All granted certificate Hopewell MM, VA in 1783. In 1810 Jason and Ann requested reinstatement at Middleton MM, OH.

1787

Sarah, Rebeckah, Ann, Jason, Joseph, minor children of Jason who some time ago removed and settled with their parents beyond the Allegany Mountain; Copy of their certificate from Fairfax MM to Hopewell MM dated 1783 forwarded to South River MM by Hopewell MM with endorsement.

Jason Morlan is the first Morlan who changed the name from Moreland. Jason's occupation was stated as a Miller. In the fall of 1801 Jason Sr., a native of Bedford County, purchased the whole section 12 and 100 acres on section 1 for homes for himself, his sons, and his two sons in laws Richard and John Tullos(Tulles). This purchase was in Elk Run Township, Columbiana County, Ohio. Jason and his wife Ann were received by request at the Middletown/Middleton monthly meeting on April 13, 1811.

Some notes on the Middleton Meeting from 1804, Travel notes:

Middleton Monthly Meeting held the 2d seventh day in every month at Middleton is composed of Middleton, 5th. day, [and] Salem (in Pennsylvania.) 4th.

Preparative meetings at each of those places, on the 4th. & 5th. days preceeding the monthly meetings.

Middleton Meeting is in what is called Bull Creek Settlement, and

the nearest for Friends at Beaver to attend about 20 or 22 miles.  
All of these Meetings belong to Redstone quarter, and Baltimore  
yearly Meeting, at present, but friends expect shortly to be allowed a  
quarterly Meeting, to be held at Short Creek or Concord.

(Moreland)<sup>3</sup>, John (Moreland)<sup>2</sup>, Benjamin (Moreland)<sup>1</sup>)<sup>24</sup> was born Abt. 1750 in Chesterfield, New Jersey<sup>25,26</sup>, and died 09 Apr 1810 in Bedford Co., VA.. He married **Mary Rhodes**<sup>26</sup> 20 Oct 1773 in Fairfax, Loudoun Co., VA., Monthly Meeting<sup>27</sup>, daughter of Moses Rhodes and Mary Mead. She was born 15 Oct 1753 in Loudoun Co., VA.<sup>27,28</sup>, and died 1830 in East Fairfield, Columbiana Co., OH.<sup>29</sup>.

Notes for Stephen Morlan:

From the George William Gillett Family History, 2005:

Stephen Morlan was the overseer for the newly formed Goose Creek Monthly Meeting House in 1786. He was recommended as an elder on August 16, 1794, for the South River Monthly Meeting in Campbell County, Virginia. He was approved as its minister in 1809.

In the early 1800's there was a migration of Quakers from Virginia into the Ohio Valley, the then "Northwest Territory". This was mainly caused by the slavery issue being so strong in Virginia.

Another cause of the migration was the Revolutionary War. Many young Quakers had joined the Revolutionary Army of Virginia, for which they were disowned by their meetings. Generally they were reinstated after the war. Those that fought in the war were granted land boundries by the legislature of Virginia in the Virginia Military District of Ohio. Over 8,000 land warrants were issued at the time to Virginia soldiers, ranging in size from 100 acres for a private who served three years to 1100 acres for a general who served three years.

Congress had also set up Federal Land Grants. Ohio was unique because it was the first area of land in the United States to have its land sold through Federal Land Offices. In 1800, the first four offices were opened in Steubenville, Chillicothe, Marietta, and Cincinnati.

Initially the settlers were required to purchase 640 acres at \$2.00 per acre but later it was reduced to 320 acres and then finally to 80 acres in 1820. This allowed more land to get into the hands of settlers, as compared to land speculators. They had five years to pay for their property.

The first records of the Steubenville, Ohio Land Office in the Northwest Territory of Ohio showed that Stephen Morlan of Bedford County, Virginia, applied for land in 1802, in which he purchased 640 acres at \$2.00 per acre or \$1,280.

His brother, Jason, had already purchased land in the Elk Run Township of Columbiana County, Ohio, in the fall of 1801. He was one of the pioneer settlers in the area. He had come north with his family and sons-in-law. In 1805, Aden Morlan, son of Stephen Morlan, settled in the area on land that Stephen Morlan had purchased.

In 1803, when the required population was reached, Ohio became a State. The county of Columbiana was erected the same year. This was all happening as the Morlan's were establishing their new home.

It was not until after Stephen Morlan's death that the remaining Morlan family members moved to Columbiana County, Ohio. This included all their living children and their families. Columbiana County is located on the Ohio - Pennsylvania border about 30 miles south of Youngstown, Ohio.

The initial settlement of Columbiana County was started around 1800 and therefore the Morlans were one of the first in the area. The county was classified as having excellent farm land. The population for the county increased as follows:

1803 - 543  
1810 - 10,878  
1820 - 22,033  
1840 - 42,662

In most cases the Morlans were listed as farmers and were not involved in day to day activities of the local governments with very few holding any government office. Most of the Morlans were active in the Quaker religion, making it easy to trace their records.

Stephen Morlan died April 9, 1810 while on a religious journey with Christopher Anthony. He was 59 years old at the time of his death. It is not too clear in his Will, dated March 3, 1810, but it appears that he had over 300 acres of land in Virginia and 440 acres in Ohio. The actual date of his death varied within the records with at least two different dates used: April 9 and August 4, 1810.

After his death in 1810, his wife, Mary (Rhodes) Morlan, traveled with her family to Columbiana County, Ohio. After her son, Richard Morlan, married Mary Erwin in 1819 in Columbiana County, she moved with them to Beaver County, Pennsylvania. Beaver County is located just east of Columbiana County.

Mary (Rhodes) Morlan died January 9, 1830, in Beaver County, Pennsylvania, at the age of 76.

From George William Gillett's Genealogy:

At the time of their marriage, on October 20, 1773, Stephen Morlan was 22 years old and his wife, Mary (Rhodes) Morlan, had just turned 20 years old. The marriage took place at the Fairfax Monthly Meeting House in Loudoun County, Virginia.

Seven years after their marriage they moved to Bedford County, Virginia. They did not inform the Quakers of the move and therefore the following letter was sent to the monthly meeting house in Bedford County.

"Application being made to us for a few lines by way of Certificate for Stephen Moreland and Mary, his wife, with their three children, namely Edwin, Abigail and Jonah, we may inform you that they left our parts without acquainting the Monthly Meeting of their intention of removing, which was contrary to the advice of our Yearly Meeting, but with respect to their conduct it appears, after the needful enquiry that their lives and conversation have been in some good degree orderly. They attended our religious meeting at times and have settled their outward affairs to satisfaction as far as we know. We therefore recommend them and their children as members of our Society to your Christian care and oversight, desiring their preservation and growth in the truth, and remain your loving friends. Signed on behalf of our Monthly Meeting at Fairfax, held November 25, 1780."
